Healthcare Career Scholarships from the Carolinas HealthCare System Blue Ridge Volunteers (CHSBRV)

OBJECTIVES

The objective of the Carolinas HealthCare Blue Ridge Volunteers scholarship is to aid financially deserving and academically promising individuals who plan to prepare themselves for a healthcare career. These scholarships are offered to Burke County high school graduates, Burke County home-schooled graduates, sons and daughters of Carolinas HealthCare System, Blue Ridge employees and sons and daughters of the Carolinas HealthCare System Blue Ridge Volunteers.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Credentials of applicants for healthcare career awards will be reviewed on a competitive basis by a selection committee, which has been approved by the Carolinas HealthCare Blue Ridge Volunteers Executive Board.

Selections for the scholarship will be based on the following criteria: financial need, scholarship achievement, personal qualifications, and professional promise. Up to two scholarships could be awarded based on merit only.

The committee will examine each applicant's interests and academic capabilities carefully. Evidence of good character and the desire to be of service to mankind will be considered of basic importance in the selection.

The selection committee, after reviewing school records and applications may call the applicants in for interviews. The decisions of the selection committee are final, and reason(s) for their decisions will not be made public.

When the recipient meets all requirements, the scholarship monies will be sent directly to the educational institution, one-half (\$500) at the beginning of the school year and one-half (\$500) at the beginning of the second semester contingent upon successful grades, a 2.5 GPA or higher, and documentation of coursework for spring semester.
